SNOW PLOW DETAILS

JHLA has contracted with MC Property, L.L.C. for our subdivision roads snow plow services. This is our eighth year with them and the cost will remain the same. Our contract season begins December 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025. They do not plow snow less than 3 inches. They also clear snow from individual driveways for a fee. Their number is 248-563-5534.

GOOSE ROUND-UP AND REMOVAL Jayno Heights will contribute to the Egg Shake & Nest Destruction fund with Adams Landing, Snug Harbor, Island Cove, Loon Lake Woods, and Silver Pointe for the 2025 season. This process with be headed by Jim Williams & Dave Forner from Adams Landing and will involve Loon Lake, Silver Lake & Schoolhouse Lake. DNR has canceled the Canada Goose Round Up Program for 2024 because of the risk of transporting HPAI (avian flu) around the state with relocating the geese. We would like to thank Vickie Klein for coordinating this program in years past.
